



PHILOSOPHY

Our educational philosophy centers around exposing and educating students both adults and children to Chinese culture, reading and writing. We strive to accomplish our goals by providing a relaxing and fun learning environment where students will be immersed in basic Chinese pronunciation and enunciation, writing, reading, singing, play acting and occasional authentic Chinese food sampling. PROGRAM

Classes are held in two semesters annually from September through May. Some of the festivities celebrated include: Dragon Boat Festival, Moon Festival and Chinese New Year.
